Terms To Be Met To Be Invited To The International Folklore Festival

- 01. PLACE** Fribourg (Switzerland)
02. DATE OF FESTIVAL 17 – 22 August 2010-05-18
03. STAY OF GROUP-..... IN FRIBOURG

Changes caused by airline schedules are subject to alternation.

- 04. TRANSPORTATION** Your group will chose its own means of transportation.

International air transportation: cost assumed by the group. Transfers are assured by the organizer once the group has arrived at an airport in Switzerland. Information concerning the dates of arrival and departure along with the flight number, flight times, and choice of airport (Geneva or Zürich) in Switzerland are to be communicated at the latest by the first day of August preceding the festival (date of arrival of the information).

International bus (coach) transportation: cost assumed by the group. International private bus (coach) transportation on Swiss territory: the following cost of transportation is assumed by the organizers: CHF 2.00 per km. covered on Swiss territory.

05. NUMBER OF PERSONS

Maximum number of persons: 38, which means 34 performers and 4 accompanying adults (director, choreographer, driver, etc.). Minimum number of persons: 5 couples of dancers and 4 musicians (no recorded music).

A list of the complete name, passport number, sex, date of birth, role of each person in the group participating in the festival has to be sent to RFI before the 30th day of May preceding the festival.

06. VISAS

All formalities involving obtaining visas to enter Switzerland and transit visas for other countries are to be carried out by the group as early as possible. Cost of the visas are assumed by the group. Please notify us that these steps have been taken by 30 June at the latest.

07. ACCOMODATION AND MEALS

RFI assumes the costs of accommodation and meals (including beverages). This commitment ends once the group has had its breakfast on the day of its departure and received its picnic lunch.

The group is accommated in communal dormitories (no private rooms available). These dormitories are spacious and have all modern conveniences but do not have windows that open and allow you to see outside. Men and women do not share facilities.

08. POCKET MONEY

The sum, that follows CIOFF norms, is fixed in the contract of final commitment that is concluded following your registration (CHF 8.00 per performer and per festival day).

Each group's registration is sent to the diplomatic representation of its country in Switzerland as well as to the CIOFF delegate in its country.

Any exception to these terms is subject to discussion. Exceptions will be included in the contract.

Any other commitment made b your group on Swiss territory (immediately before and after the Fribourg International Folklore Festival) will have to be mentioned to the organizers of this festival.
